

Weave your own Red Hen woollen coaster!


Poke a short length of wool through CD centre and tie a loop around CD. Once secure, wrap the wool around CD passing through the centre each time. Make sure you have an odd number of loops (9 or 11 work well). It doesn't need to be tight but some tension will help. Tie off the end to fasten. This is your warp.

Choose a short length of a new wool and tie off the end to any loop. Using the enclosed needle begin to weave the wool under and over the warp, working from the centre of the CD round and round. This is your weft.

To change colour simply tie your wool length to a new one, remove loose ends and continue weaving over and under.

On reaching the outer edge of the CD, tie your current length of wool off and remove loose ends.
